## VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT Meet Maureen Dixon

When Maureen Dixon reflects on her experience as a Victoria Hospice volunteer, she speaks with conviction: “It’s about giving people a safe place to grieve alongside others who truly understand. A place where there’s no judgement, just kindness and understanding.”

Maureen joined Victoria Hospice as a volunteer eight years ago, after a long career as a school principal in Red Deer. Her time supporting grieving families there left a lasting impact, inspiring her to continue that support in her retirement.

Since 2017, she has been a dedicated volunteer on the Inpatient Unit every Friday morning, her radiant smile and compassion brightening everyone’s day.

Beyond the Inpatient Unit, Maureen is a valued member of the Bereavement volunteer team. She has lent her support to the Walking Group, Grief Cafés, and Living with Grief workshops, skillfully supporting people navigate the complexities of grief.

A life-long learner, Maureen welcomes opportunities to improve her skills for the benefit of patients, clients, and families. She also mentors new volunteers, sharing her wealth of experience and guiding them through their initial shifts on the Unit.

In 2024, Maureen was named an Honorary Lifetime Member of the Victoria Hospice Society, recognizing her outstanding contributions over the years.

## Hospice Hearts Club Members recognized at the Community Support Centre

Last fall, Victoria Hospice unveiled a new donor wall to recognize our generous community of monthly donors, fondly referred to as the Hospice Heart Club. Liz Johnson, a dedicated member, attended the unveiling and knows firsthand the impact of monthly contributions.

Liz's husband Ian received end-of-life support from Victoria Hospice in 2023. A former

nurse, Liz was Ian's primary caregiver, with support from the Palliative Response Team, until his care needs exceeded what could be managed at home. Transferred to the Inpatient Unit, Ian spent his final days surrounded by compassionate care, allowing Liz to simply be there as his wife.

"You never know when you or a loved one will need hospice. Victoria Hospice was there for Ian and me when we needed it most. They bring heaven to earth," Liz says.

## Animal Therapy on the Unit!

Victoria Hospice has partnered with the Pacific Animal Therapy Society (PATS) to bring therapy dogs on-site twice a week. Every Monday and Wednesday afternoon, patients and staff can connect with these specially trained canines.

One of these dogs is Brio, a seasoned therapy dog at Royal Jubilee Hospital who has recently joined Victoria Hospice with her humans, Kit Pearson and Katherine Farris.

Research shows that petting a dog or cat can reduce blood pressure, calm the heart, and alleviate stress, anxiety, and depression. For those approaching end-of-life, spending time with a pet may also provide pain relief and spiritual connection.

Victoria Hospice LPN Kirsten highlights the value of therapy dogs. "It's amazing to offer patients who have loved animals their whole lives the chance to enjoy companionship at the end of their lives. It has a calming effect that brings so much comfort, and the staff love it, too!"

Each Monday and Wednesday, one of seven teams will spend an hour on the unit, prioritizing visits to patients who wish to see the dog. The length of visits varies based on demand.
